

## **It's Summer in the Philippines**

We are in camp this week! 60 campers are up in the mountain at our campsite, Refuge Mtn Bible Campgrounds, with Dan and our associate Pastor, Mike Mendiola. On May 17-21 a second and larger camp will be held for a fellowship group of 5 mountain churches. We are expecting 150 campers that week. Pray for the need of additional trained counselors and staff.

Last Sunday we broke ground, following our morning service, for our new Pre-School facility going up on our church compound. With over a 100 small children attending classes in the present building in our back yard, we have run out of space and have very little area for parking. It is time to take a step forward. Please be in prayer for the many needs for this project, 4 classrooms and a reception area.

Edna is now using only one crutch. She can actually take a few steps unassisted. However the fracture is not completely filled in, so the doctor doesn't want her putting too much weight on that leg yet....slow but sure. Considering we were told last year she had stage 4 cancer, we are doing marvelously well and both thrilled and rejoicing in the results of our chosen homeopathic route. X-rays are showing continued improvement and new bone growth. All labs have remained normal. Next week we go to Singapore in order to have a PET scan done and see an oncologist there. It is far less expensive to have it done there, rather than in Manila. One of our church families provided our plane tickets. A church in Singapore has offered a place to stay, so mainly we will have only the medical expenses and meals to cover. God's provision is always on time.

The Lord has opened another door of opportunity for Dan in Valencia, a city south of where we live. Two former college friends and their families, and a gov't official accepted Christ just last week in 3 different Bible studies. They are asking for these Bible studies to continue. We have two church families living in that area as well and all of these families have businesses good for a potential new church plant. So please pray for His wisdom for our guidance and their spiritual growth

So please pray for 1) the on-going camp and camp next month 2) for our medical trip next week, 3) on-going construction of the new PreSchool building which will also serve for nursery facilities for our church, 4) Dan's new Bible studies in Valencia. Finally please pray for our son

Joseph, his wife Kristin and two children, along with our daughter Anna who will be visiting us the end of May through the first two weeks of June. Safety in traveling and a good visit while home, the first time for Kristin to travel overseas.
