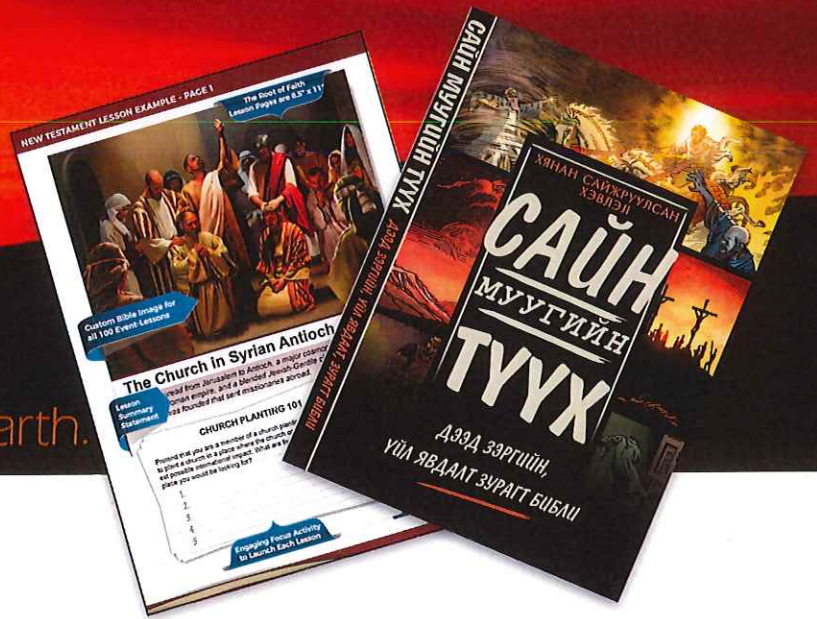


# Mongolian MISSIONS
