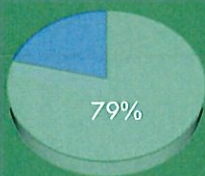

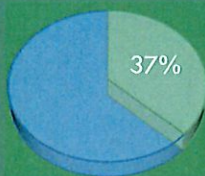

The year of 2020 is an exciting year for us, and we cannot wait to tell you all about it! But first, we wish to share with you some events from December and an amazing story of God's hand at work.

Japan Update

Our ministry trip to Japan was such a blessing. We are so thankful God gives us abilities and then gives us opportunities to use them! We held two concerts at the Bible college and one in each of the ten churches we visited. Each night, the Gospel was presented by Gage's father, Pastor Ronnie Gilbert. As a result, five souls accepted Jesus Christ! Outside of music, Gage had the opportunity to preach at one supporting church and Aleah gave her testimony at another church.

While we sought to be a blessing to the Japanese Christians, they were a much greater blessing to us! They were genuine, hospitable, and kind; they took such good care of us, making sure we were well fed and provided for. We are very thankful for them!

When God is at Work

At the evening concert with the Bible college, two men from another country attended. They both heard a clear presentation of the Gospel. Following the concert was a fellowship in which these two men also attended. During that time the men were personally spoken to, and they both accepted Christ! It was found out that the men are from Fiji, but they are not just from Fiji, they are from the very town that missionaries Robbie and Amanda Leonard are working in! The two Fijian men were thrilled to return home to meet the Leonards and help them start a church. The Leonards just arrived in Fiji and they already have at least two converts to minister to. God is amazing!

Next Steps

Being at 79% support, we are praying and believing that God will allow us to finish deputation by the end of spring! This means our next goal is to jump into language school. There are two languages spoken in Greenland: Greenlandic and Danish. Danish is the trade language and provides the resources for learning Greenlandic. Because there is no language school in Greenland, we are currently planning to spend several months in Copenhagen, Denmark, beginning in June, to attend an intensive, immersive language course. The difficulty is not taking the class but being permitted to stay in Denmark. We can stay three months without issue, but it would be much more beneficial to stay in country for six months. Please pray with us that, Lord willing, He will allow us the proper visa to stay the extra three months.

Thank you for your continual prayers, support, and love gifts. We are overwhelmed by God's provision through His people. He truly meets every need!
