

Dear Pastors and Supporting Churches,

Thank you for your continued prayer and financial support. We are so thankful for your faithfulness and for our Lord who knows our needs before we do!

We are rejoicing with the Salvation of Ray and Leanne. Through God's providence, I met them walking down the road Saturday as I was returning home. I stopped and asked if they needed a ride. Once they got in the van, Leanne began crying and telling all that was "going on" at the house with Ray's parents. I asked if they would like to come to the house and talk and they both said yes. We spent three hours talking about many things but conversation always went back to the fact that they, as well as Ray's mom, needed to be saved. Finally, Leanne asked how she could be saved. I went through the gospel again very simply with her and she bowed and prayed asking God to save her. Ray then said that he wanted to repent of his sin and be saved and he too prayed and asked God to save him. Please continue to pray for them! Much of our conversation before their prayer was about the fact that they are living together and are not married. I told them that God says fornication is sin and they need to separate until they are married. **Please continue to pray for the mother, Fina.** She and her son Daniel have not yet made professions of Salvation and Fina seems very bitter toward the rest of the family for doing so. She was the "religious" one of the family and the one that insisted that they all come to church to start with; however, she thinks that she is fine because she has been baptized and she is a "good person."

We also had a great start to our Children's Bible Club Friday! We had 12 non-Hendersons in attendance at the first club and 6 new children at the second one this morning! Most of these are brand new contacts that have never visited the church. Our neighbor allowed her children to attend and during game time in the yard, the mom was videoing her son running the circle and laughing and cheering him on! The grandmother came over Friday after club and said to let her know if there is anything she can do for us. This is such a blessing as we see walls coming down! I can still count a lot more children in the village that have shown interest and say that they want to attend! **Please pray that I can get to the parents for permission.** At one set of apartments down the road there is anywhere from 10-20 children outside playing at any given time. I stopped again this morning on the way back to club and begged them to come. They all say that they want to go with me but they will not go get any parents. Most say that their parents aren't home or are asleep. Each time I leave our information and tell them I'll be back! **Please pray also that we will have the help we need if they do all come at the same time!**

This month feels like it has been full of visits up north with doctors and dentists. Revis had more work on his tooth but it is not finished yet. Hopefully, one more visit but the dentist is "off island" and we are not exactly sure of when his return will be. Thankfully, Revis is not in any pain anymore and the tooth should be fine for a while with the temporary filling. Tonja had an emergency visit to the dentist also when a tooth broke off. Maggie got an infection in a toe that required two visits and two antibiotics. Please continue to pray as it is still not completely healed. Then, I had my appointment for my shoulder on the 24th. The doctor wanted a more recent MRI since my last one was over a year and half ago. I had the MRI on the 25th and returned for the results the following week. The good news is that we now know what is wrong with my shoulder. He found a tear in the rotator cuff where it attaches to the shoulder bone. He suggested surgery and said that while the doctor is in there, he recommends cutting off a small section of my collar bone where it connects to my acromion bone to create a space where arthritis has set in; as well as shaving the underside of the AC joint for the same purpose. He also suggested that we go to the Philippines to have the work done where he said the cost would be half of what we will find here on island. He is going to have his office work up an estimate here on island and also try to get one from the PI. We are waiting on that call. **Please pray for the pain to ease so that I will be able to sleep at night.**
