Dear Camp Creek Baptist Church,

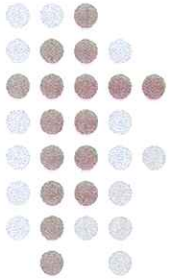

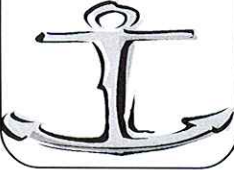
Thank you so much for your prayers and support. We endeavor to do our best to be missionaries worthy of your support. God Bless you with a Blessed New Year.

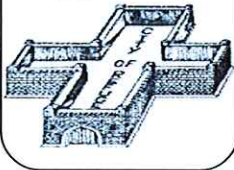

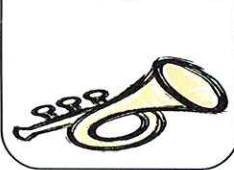
Anchor Academy for Boys [ages 13-17]

Jubilee Home for Ladies [ages 18+]

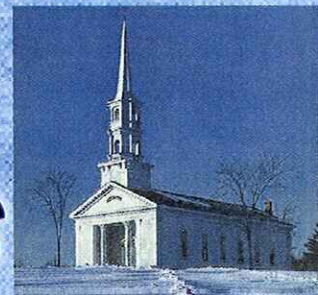


Lighthouse Home for young Men [ages 18-24]
