Dear Friends,

I want to say i am sorry this newsletter is late, I wanted to wait Until the summer crusades were over so I could give you reports of what happened and now the hurricane has devestated Haiti and many of our churches there, In the crusades this summer we were able to hold them in two different locations on the island. The one on the North end of Haiti was in a new area with 137 people coming to know Christ as saviour. There were 15 weddings and 14 baptisms. A new church will be started there as well. The other crusade was in the central part of Hait with 97 people coming to Christ with 5 weddings.

I am just beginning to receive reports concerning the hurricane, In Port-au Prince we lost the church and three lives. Pray for our pastors and the people there. In Petite River the church was destroyed with two fatalities. In Montrouis (our headquarters) the church had one wall collapse and someone stole everything out of the church. I am sure there will be many more stories of destruction and loss of life as the days go by.

On New Providence Island where we have several works the area of Coral Harbor every house was destroyed or received heavy damage.

I really need your prayers and financial help at this time. The pastors are looking to us for help in rebuilding their works and only God knows how it will all be accomplished. I am not complaining because God has great plans for the works in Haiti and the islands this is just a time when we need to pray more and lean upon Him.

Our church here has started another ministry in helping the homeless in our area with food, and it has opened doors to share the gospel with them. The sheriff's department is helping us distribute it to the homeless camps here.

I will try to write more as I hear from the churches so you will know how to pray. I do know that it is bad there right now. Please remember us in your prayers.
