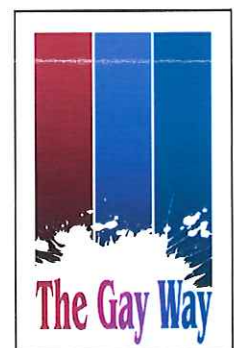
Hope Tract Ministry,

Thank You for sending tracts here to Easterling. To be on the safe side, do not send more than 100 at a time to any one individual. This camp is thirsty for The Good News and rest assured, God's Word does not return to Him void. I can not pass tracts out fast enough.

Because our chaplain does not like us Evangelizing our yard, we are never sure how many we can receive. But if you are willing to risk it for the sake of soul's salvation, you can send me a sample pack or two every now and then.

THE GAY WAY REACHES A MAN IN AL. PRISON

We received a long letter from a man in a Alabama prison who received our tract entitled, "The Gay Way" and wrote to explain how God had showed him that it was OK to be gay. He used a lot of Scripture in his arguments and did his best to convince us. We saw various indicators that his letter was a cry for help. We wrote back and properly explained each Scripture he used and gave him quite a few other passages to consider. We were very pleased when he wrote back again and had a completely different perspective. He no longer tried to justify homosexuality but asked for help in turning away from it. We were able to give him some further instruction from the Bible. God's Word is powerful and will cut to the heart of anyone who is willing to receive it.
