We had 10 children come forward for salvation during the first half of the school year. Please pray for all the volunteers as they work with these children each week. Please pray for my mother as her health continues to decline. She has been a Christian for many years which is the greatest blessing of all. God bless you and thank you for having a part in my ministries.
