Traveling and Encouraging Others

Before the Bible college started, I had the privilege of traveling with Miss Zami to Matupi town in Chin State and Dawei city in Tanintharyi Division. They requested for us to come and encourage the women there. So, we taught and encouraged them from the Bible for three whole days in each place. Over 12 women turned out for our teaching sessions. This experience was the first time for both of us to give training to women in a local church. We were worried and nervous, but we made it through to the end. We were blessed already by just seeing their eager and attentive faces. While in Dawei, we were given a grand tour of the city and the beautiful beach. The believers there are lovely and have great zeal for the Lord.



Biblical School of Theology started its first semester in June. There are more than 150 students this year. I was privileged to teach two undergraduate classes this year: Bible Manner and Custom and ESL classes. Also, Miss Zami and I supervised the ladies' dorm and led prayer meeting twice a week.

Hope Children Home:



During summer, all the kids at Hope Children Home attended youth camp. They made many new friends and enjoyed the camp. At the end of the camp, we rejoiced to see five children from our Hope Children Home give their testimonies of salvation through believer's baptism! What a joy to see our Hope kids desire to walk in truth!

We accepted three new children in May: LiLy, Tun Tun, and Lian Lian. They all came from different parts of Myanmar. Lily is in 5th grade, Tun Tun in 4th grade, and Lian Lian sits in 3rd grade. They are adjusting very well to the new environment. In July, they had their first annual school exam. Lily and Tun Tun passed their exam with all C's. Surprisingly, Lian Lian received all A's. We know they studied very hard and strived for good grades. We are proud of their achievements.
