Dear Church Family at Camp Creek Baptist Church

We apologize that we are delayed again in getting our letters out, and I had not wanted to send out two together, but needed to get these new updates and requests to you.

Dannette is back to 100% (pretty much ☺) after her surgery and still no cancer recurrence as of her last follow-up appointment.

Our daughter is still seeing doctors on a *too* frequent basis - and - as yet, for undiagnosed problems. Almost weekly there are new problems which lead to new specialists, but so far there is still no cancer diagnosis. We are praising the Lord for what good news we get along the way! Please keep Anna and her family in your prayers as our Lord brings her to mind - for physical health and spiritually.

Our son Samuel will be having major reconstructive surgery on his left ankle and foot at the end of May. It has been delayed until then for our schedule to ease up a bit, because he will not be able to put any weight on that foot - at all - for 8 to 12 weeks after the surgery. Please pray for him, for healing and grace. We are not sure how he will do with all of the drastic changes that he will face, plus the pain and therapy ??? The mixture of Down Syndrome with a bit of Autism keeps life interesting when dealing with any changes. Samuel's right ankle and foot will be operated on 6 to 12 months after the left foot, depending on his recovery.

The FTL continues to print and ship tracts daily, in February surpassing 4.6 billion total tracts shipped ... but is still limited by the needed building addition being delayed. We cannot add any new languages, nor get our second full color press set up and running, along with several other critical needs that this addition will take care of. The Fellowship Baptist Church and the Fellowship Tract League have operated on a cash basis for years, *and we do praise the Lord for His provision...* but the banks have declined a construction loan for the addition, because there is no "credit" history for decades....
