Our usual activities are proceeding as normal with weekly institute classes on Monday, midweek Bible studies now being taught by Mr. Biney on Tuesday, outreaches at Good Samaritan School and Brenu village on Wednesday, and church activities and radio program on Sunday. Brother Eric is now conducting a youth meeting at the resource center on Fridays and a youth outreach at the church property on Sunday afternoons.

Starting this Sunday evening, we are going to begin a weekly evangelistic service. Each week, we will be looking at different aspects of the gospel. Since we are adding the evangelistic service, we will be rescheduling the radio program to Thursday evenings. With this program change, we will likely be reaching a new listening audience, so please pray that God will work in many hearts through this change.

As usual, every June brings a battle with the rains. With new construction going on all around the church land, it has brought drainage challenges. We are in the midst of completing a wall around the property. When the wall is finished, we hope the water will not be able to pass onto the property as it has been.

This past month, Joel started a baptism and membership class with six people desiring to join the church. We are excited to see these people desiring to follow the Lord and be united with our local church.

We also praise the Lord for answer to prayer concerning a former church member. About a year ago, one of our young men left the church over some serious doctrinal issues. We appealed to him with the Scriptures, but at the time were unable to see repentance. This past month, he has come back to resolve the matter and be reunited with the church. We pray that his motives are sincere, and that the Lord has truly changed his heart on these issues, and we praise God for the step he has taken.
