Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus! Thank you for your continued support of this ministry in the amount of \$100.00.

This past month has proved to be busy for the home on many fronts. I am thankful that the Lord is always found faithful and gives us what we need when we need it.

September may have to be renamed "Accident Awareness Month" at the home. On separate occasions this month, three of our children sustained minor injuries. The first occasion happened at the beginning of the month when Nevaeh's top teeth went completely through her lip. This accident required several stitches. On the second occasion, Shawn was running in the gymnasium and ran right into a younger girl-breaking a permanent top tooth in the girl's forehead! He has already been to four dentist appointments just to see what can be done. The permanent tooth is very young, which limits the options available. The last occasion involved Vincent having an accident on the school playground and fracturing his wrist. Please keep these children in your prayers. It's not a good thing when the ER staff starts to know my name!

This month, we have moved the older boys to the remodeled rooms in the adjoining dorm. This move proved to be a major undertaking. Although it seemed like we hit every obstacle possible during this transition, we have now settled in for the most part. Hopefully, we can start enjoying the wonderful rooms that have been prepared for the children.

We are still away from the home at least three or more times a week in effort to raise the support needed to cover the day to day operational expenses. We have been traveling for several months without the help of our big bus. Because the bus has been in the shop, the children have had to travel as a caravan in a smaller bus and several cars in order to get to these meetings. We are definitely thankful that the Lord has protected us on these trips. We are also thankful to hear that our bus should be ready by the end of the week. The cost of the repairs exceeds \$7,000.00 and doesn't include the extra trip to the shop to fix the heating and air conditioning. If you would like to help with the cost of these repairs, we would be greatly appreciative. Thank you to our new supporters. It's a blessing to see how the Lord is meeting our financial needs.


We saw a huge prayer request answered last month. The Lord saw fit to grant the home favor with the judge concerning three of our children-they are allowed to stay with us. Many times, we need to transport more children than a small car will hold, but the buses that we have available require a CDL licensed driver.
