Meanwhile, all is well in Liberia. This is election year (2017). General and presidential elections are scheduled for October. Campaigns are going on right now all around the country.

For the school, we had our closing program on June 25. Five students graduated from the 6<sup>th</sup> grade. They will be going to a new school for the 2017-2018 school year. Our school is only up to the 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Twelve students graduated from the kindergarten and promoted to the first grade. About sixteen students from the nursery class were promoted to K-4. We are planning for a computer lab for next year.

Our discipleship class also closed in June. The program is mainly for the students in the school. We have few children who come from the community.

Please continue to pray with us for our church land. The case is still in court. The judge who was over the case passed away a few months ago. A new judge has not been assigned.
